



Highlights for the Year 2010

- Profit attributable to equity holders of the Company increased by 8.0% to **HK\$401.3 million**, as compared against last year
- Turnover recorded a growth of 9.2% as compared against last year
- At 31 December 2010, cash and bank deposits was HK\$327.0 million
- Final dividend of HK7.1 cents, together with interim dividend of HK2.4 cents, the total dividends payment for the year of HK9.5 cents, represent a dividend payout ratio of 53.1%



Laying Foundation for Future Growth


- Change of name to CITIC Telecom International Holdings Limited

- The upgrading/development of Global MPLS network was completed, paving the way for the next generation IP telecom environment









Turnover increased 9.2% to HK\$2,966.5 million when compared with last year



Turnover of Four Major Business Segments













Turnover Breakdown






Profit Growth



Shareholding Structure as at 31 December 2010







Major Business Segment – Voice Services


- Expanded voice product portfolio (e.g. 3G video call, ITFC and HCD), High Definition (HD) Voice Traffic on IPX Network

- Alphabet Caller ID functioned on SMS among all Hong Kong operators





- Being the hub of Prepaid Roaming Services in Macau and Taiwan
- Provided Internet Protocol Packet Exchange (IPX), which was a one-stop-shop turnkey solution for IDD voice, mobile roaming signaling, SMS messaging and roaming data services for both mobile, fixed network operators as well as Internet Service Providers (ISP)
